Laguna Hills High School Instrumental Music

The following rules apply to all instrumental activities to all instrumental activities on campus and on trips. These rules have been established to promote the safety of all ensemble members and to ensure that the actions of the ensemble members reflect favorably on the organization, the school, and the community.

- All SVUSD rules and regulations apply to all students, on all Instrumental/Color Guard activities.
- All members will conduct themselves in a courteous, appropriate and respectful manner to all students, staff, chaperones and anyone else encountered in an instrumental activity. Students will listen and follow the directions given to them by staff members, chaperones and the Director.
- Each ensemble member is responsible for knowing the activity schedule and being on time.
- The LHHS Instrumental Program will always stay together as a group or as designated subgroups. Ensemble members may not depart from an activity/location without the expressed consent of the Director.
- Foul and abusive language will not be tolerated.
- Consumption of any alcoholic beverage, smoking or chewing tobacco, electronic cigarettes, or any other illegal substance is prohibited.
- Students will not engage in any form of inappropriate activity with anyone at any time during the group's activity.
- Large, electronic devices (laptops, game consoles, etc.) or valuables are not allowed on any trip.
- Students are responsible for the correct handling of their assigned uniform. Any uniform damaged as a result of not following the given protocol or the loss of any pieces of the uniform will be the financial responsibility of the student.
- All items are the personal responsibility of the student. The program and all parties related to the program are not financially responsible for the loss of any equipment or personal items.

Administrative action for any student found in violation of these rules include but are not limited to:

- At a local event, parent(s) or guardian will be called to immediately pick-up their child at the location of the event.
- Or student will be sent home on the first available means of transportation from the event. The costs associated with the escorting chaperone's round trip will be at the expense of the parent(s) or guardian.
- Student will be referred to school authorities for further disciplinary action.
- Other disciplinary methods may be employed at the discretion of the Director.
