

ACTIVITY POLICY

Laguna Hills High School Instrumental Music

The following rules apply to all instrumental activities at home and on trips. These rules have been established to promote the safety of all band members and to ensure that the actions of band members reflect favorably on the band, the school, and the community.

- All SVUSD rules and regulations apply to all students, on all instrumental activities.
- All members will conduct themselves in a courteous, appropriate, and respectful manner to all students, staff, chaperones, and anyone else encountered in an instrumental activity. Students will listen and follow the directions given to them by staff members, chaperones, and the Director. Foul and abusive language will not be tolerated.
- Each band member is responsible for knowing the activity schedule and being on time.
- Consumption of any alcoholic beverage, smoking or chewing tobacco, electronic cigarettes, or any other illegal substance is prohibited.
- The LHHS instrumental Program will stay together as a group or as designated subgroups at all times. Band members may not leave the hotel or depart from an activity/location without the expressed consent of the Director.
- On trips, male and female band members may visit each other's room before curfew. The door to the hotel room must be fully open.
- Students will not engage in any form of sexual or roughhousing contact with anyone at any time during band activities.
- On trips, curfew hours will be announced daily and will be followed. Students are not to leave their assigned rooms or open doors during curfew hours.
- Students are not to use hotel phones to call room to room or order any form of room service or media (movies, music, games, etc.)
- Large, electronic devices or valuables are not allowed on any trip.
- Students are responsible for all damages, missing items, and any other miscellaneous charges incurred in their room. If the responsible student(s) cannot be identified, all students who share the room will share the cost equally.
- All items are the personal responsibility of the student. The program and all parties related to the program are not financially responsible for the loss of any equipment or personal items.

Administrative action for any student found in violation of these rules include but are not limited to:

- Student will be sent home on the first available means of transportation, including the costs associated with an escorting chaperone's round trip, at the expense of their parent(s) or guardian.
- Student will be referred to school authorities for further disciplinary action.
- Other disciplinary methods may be employed at the discretion of the Director.
